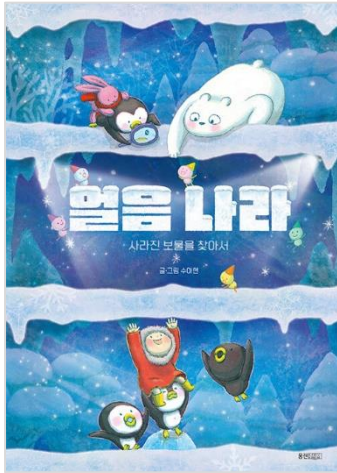


# Ice Land: To Find the Lost Treasure
