Even though she went to the African rainforest with a passion for Chimpanzees, waiting is the only option that Jane can choose to build a relationship with chimpanzees when she couldn't even narrow the distance to 500 meters from them for more than a half year.

To her granddaughter who is confused by the unfamiliar feeling of first love, grandma, Jane, shares her own experience that acknowledgment and consideration are where to start for the relationship.
