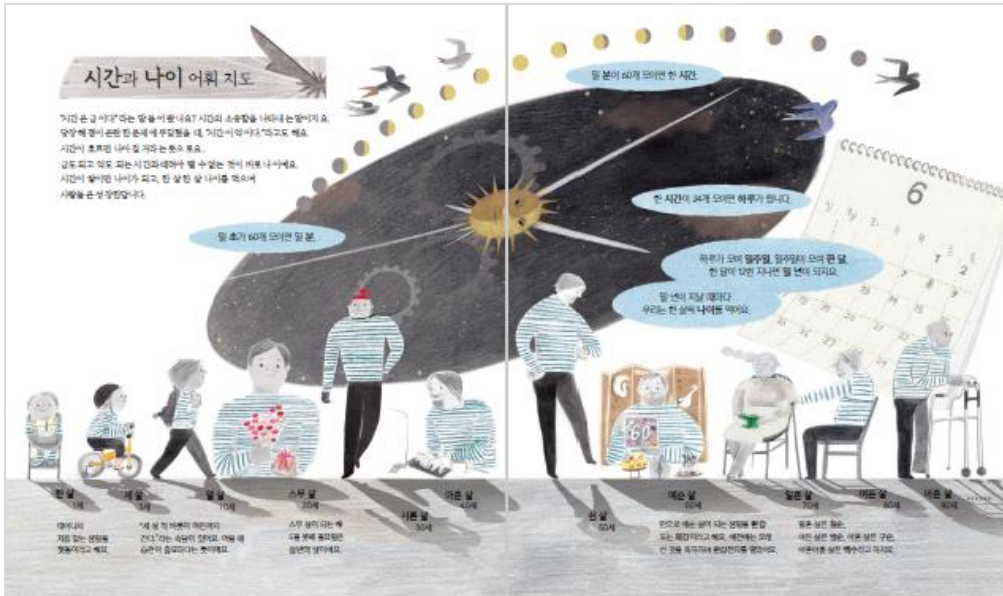
A Story about a boy setting for a journey to find time.
