Lee Jeok, a singer and writer, graduated from Seoul National University with a major in sociology. He made his debut as member of project band Panic and Carnival. He released hit songs, It is Mercy ; Don't worry, Dear ; The Meaning of Solitude, etc. One of them, Made of Wood won the 'Album of the Year', 'Song of the Year', 'Best Pop Album' and 'Best Pop Song' from the Korean Music Awards in 2008. In 2005, he published a collection of short fantasy fictions entitled <Fingerprint Hunter>, and one of the episode <The story of Mr. Self-fault> was made as an animation in 2007.
