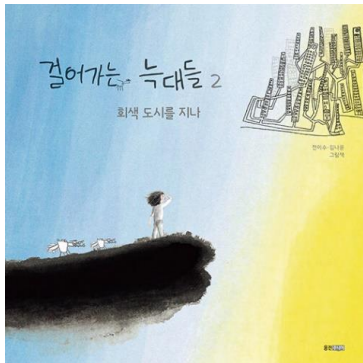


The Wolves Passing Through the Gray City

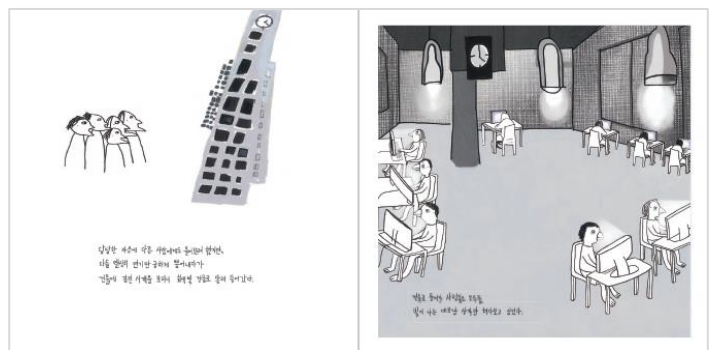
