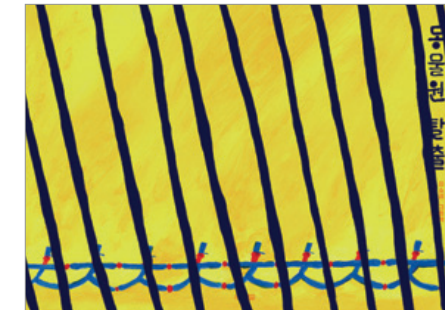
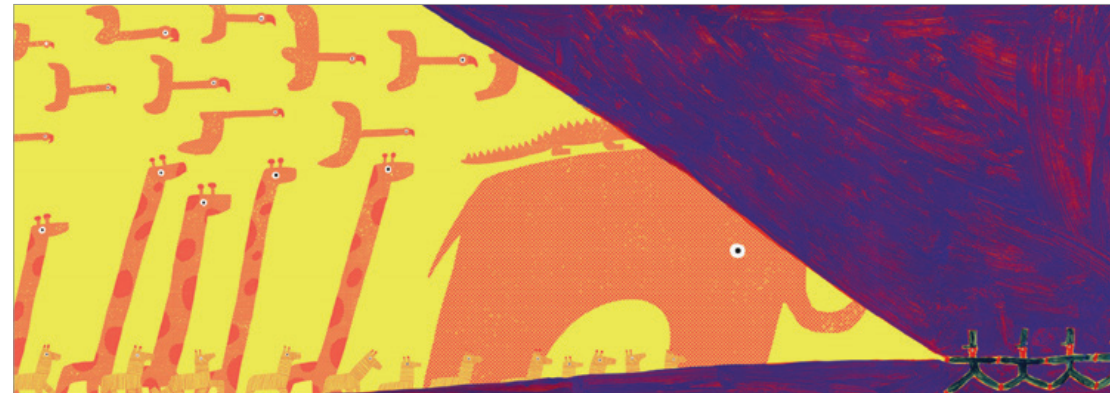

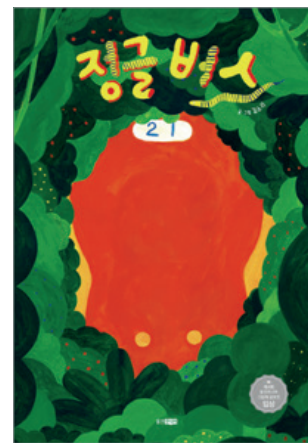


Escape From a Zoo

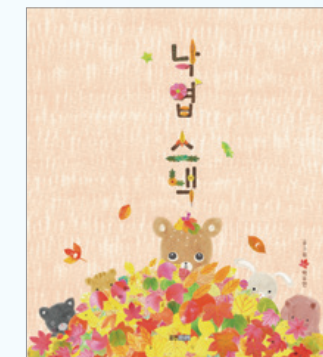

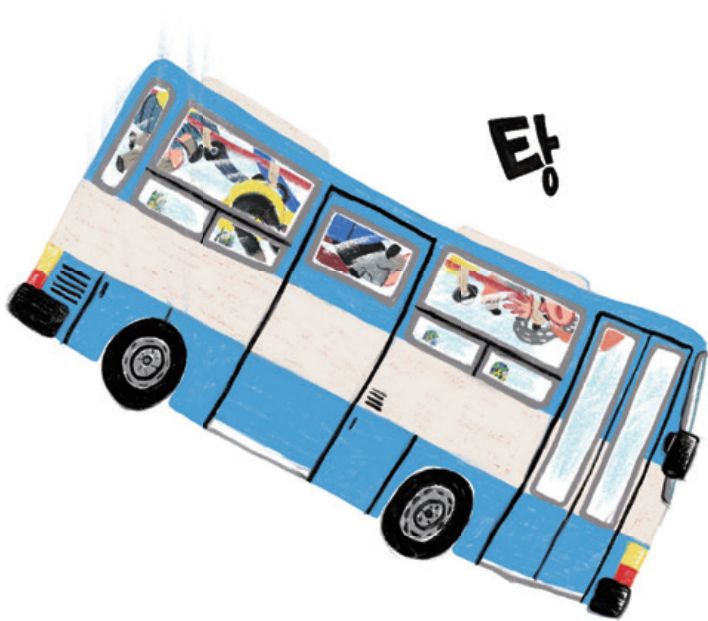


Faces of Eternity

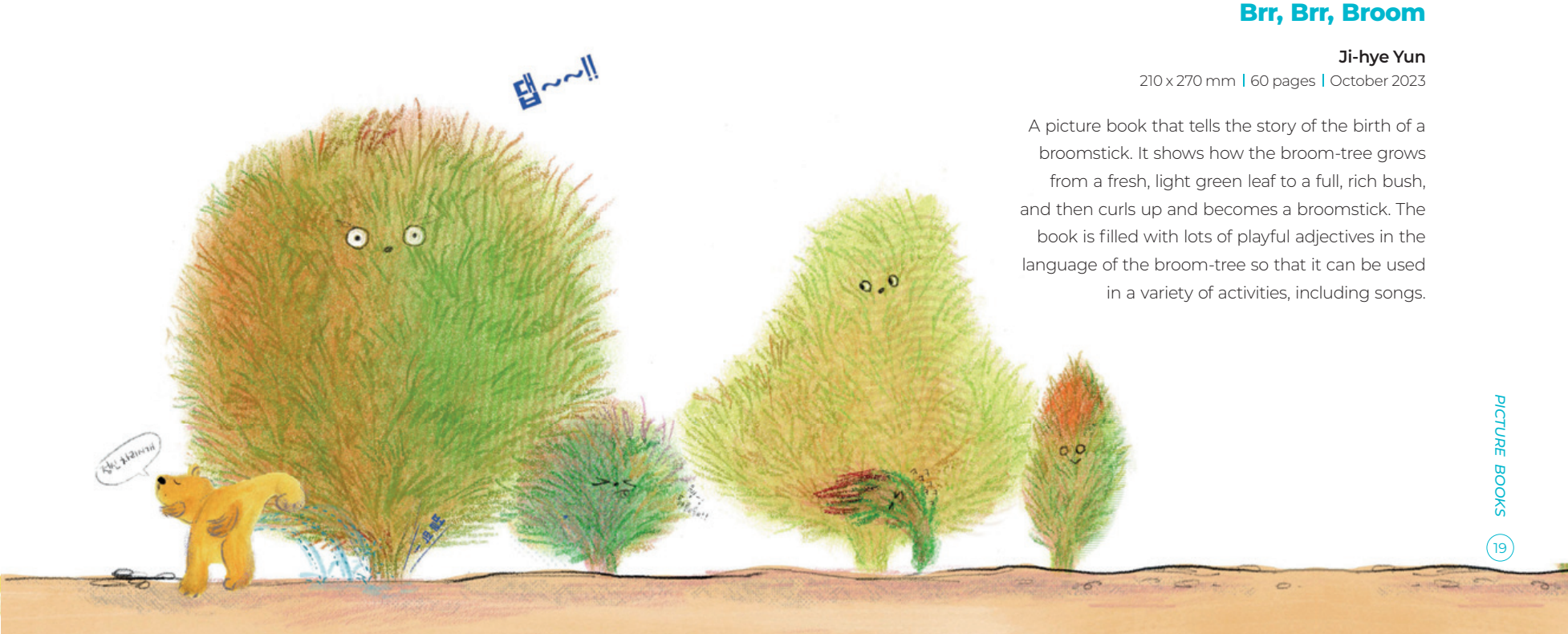


Shaking Shaking Bammm!
