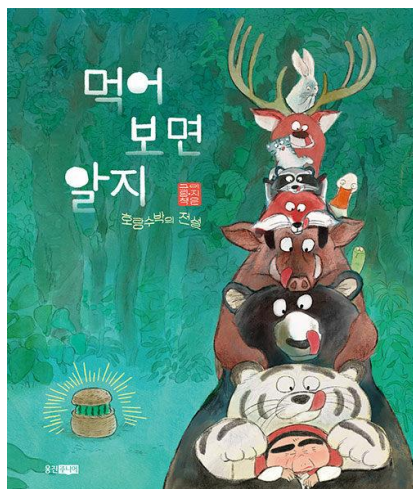

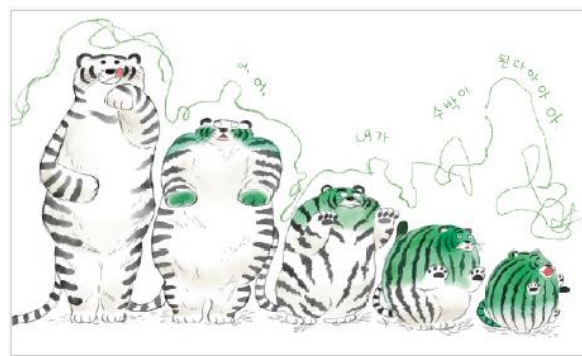

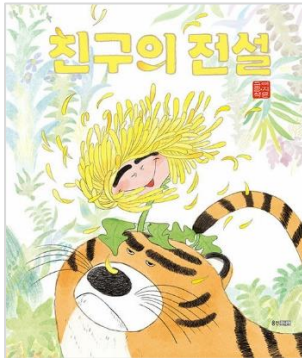


Author Biography

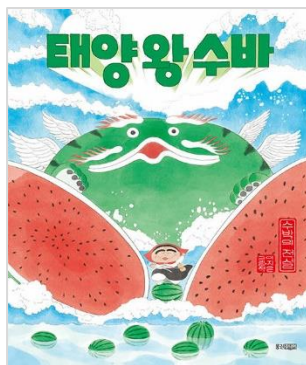
The Story How the Korean Shaved Ice Dessert was Born
